## LAN AIRLINES MONTHLY STATISTICS REPORT FOR OCTOBER 2005

Santiago, Chile, November 11, 2005 – LAN Airlines S.A. and its related companies, (“LAN” or “the Company”) (NYSE: LFL / IPSA: LAN) one of the leading airline groups in Latin America, reported its preliminary monthly and accumulated traffic statistics and punctuality indicators for October 2005.

System passenger traffic for October increased 6.7% as capacity rose of 3.2%. As a result, the Company’s load factor increased 2.4 points to 72.9%.

International passenger traffic for October increased 8.4% as capacity increased 5.4%. Accordingly, the international passenger load factor for the month increased 2.0 points to 73.0%. Capacity growth slowed relative to previous months due to specific factors, such as adverse weather conditions in the United States and Chile. Load factors grew due to strong demand on routes to the United States, Europe, and the South Pacific as well as between Latin American markets; and also as a result of growth in the domestic markets of Peru and Argentina.

Domestic passenger traffic in Chile decreased 2.3% as capacity contracted 7.9%. As a consequence, the domestic load factor for the month increased 4.2 points to 72.6%. Domestic capacity decreased mainly due to itinerary adjustments and weather conditions.

Cargo traffic decreased 1.3% as capacity was reduced 0.3%. As a consequence, load-factors decreased 0.7 points to 69.1%. Capacity decreased due to adjustments in the Company’s freighter mix in order to improve efficiency, as well as the suspension of operations at the Miami airport caused by Hurricane Wilma. Load-factors decreased as lower export traffic out of Latin America has been partially offset by higher import volumes into the region.

In October, 81.9% of the Company’s total flights left on time, based on a fifteen-minute standard (all departures leaving within fifteen minutes of scheduled departure time are considered as “on-time”). This represented a 5.1-point decrease compared to October 2004.
