LAN AIRLINES MONTHLY STATISTICS REPORT FOR NOVEMBER 2005

Santiago, Chile, December 9, 2005 – LAN Airlines S.A. and its related companies, (“LAN” or “the Company”) (NYSE: LFL / IPSA: LAN) one of the leading airline groups in Latin America reported its preliminary monthly and accumulated traffic statistics and punctuality indicators for November 2005.

System passenger traffic for November increased 10.9% as capacity rose of 6.9%. As a result, the Company’s load factor increased 2.7 points to 73.9%.

International passenger traffic for November increased 13.1% as capacity increased 7.3%. Accordingly, the international passenger load factor for the month increased 3.8 points to 74.2%. Load factors grew due to strong demand on routes to the United States, Europe, the South Pacific, and between Latin American markets, as well as due to growth in the domestic markets of Peru and Argentina.

Domestic passenger traffic in Chile increased 1.3% as capacity rose of 5.2%. As a consequence, the domestic load factor for the month decreased 2.8 points to 72.3%. Domestic load factors decreased mainly due to a strong comparison base.

Cargo traffic increased 0.3% as capacity was reduced 0.5%. As a consequence, load-factors increased 0.5 points to 69.7%. Capacity decreased due to adjustments in the Company’s freighter mix in order to increase efficiency. Load-factors increased as lower export traffic out of Latin America has been offset by higher import volumes into the region.

In November, 83.2% of the Company’s total flights left on time, based on a fifteen-minute standard (all departures leaving within fifteen minutes of scheduled departure time are considered as “on-time”). This represented a 2.2-point decrease compared to same month of 2004.
