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## **LAN AIRLINES MONTHLY STATISTICS REPORT FOR DECEMBER 2005**

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Santiago, Chile, January 10, 2006 – LAN Airlines S.A. and its related companies, (“LAN” or “the Company”) (NYSE: LFL / IPSA: LAN) one of Latin America’s leading airline groups, reported its preliminary monthly and accumulated traffic statistics and punctuality indicators for December 2005.

System passenger traffic for December increased 12.6% as capacity rose of 8.5%. As a result, the Company’s load factor increased 2.7 points to 72.8%.

International passenger traffic for December increased 16.4% as capacity increased 11.0%. Accordingly, the international passenger load factor for the month increased 3.4 points to 73.9. Traffic grew due to strong demand on routes to the United States, Europe, the South Pacific, and between Latin American markets, as well as due to growth in the domestic markets of Peru and Argentina.

Domestic passenger traffic and capacity in Chile decreased 5.3% and 2.8% respectively. As a consequence, the domestic load factor for the month decreased 1.7 points to 66.6%. Domestic load factor decreased due to schedule adjustments and fewer holiday weekends compared to the previous year.

Cargo traffic increased 3.2% as capacity rose 3.0%. As a consequence, load-factors increased 0.1 points to 69.5%. The Company increased capacity efficiently by replacing aircraft operating under ACMI leases for its new Boeing 767-300F freighters.

In December, 87.8% of the Company’s total flights left on time, based on a fifteen-minute standard (all departures leaving within fifteen minutes of scheduled departure time are considered as “on-time”). This represented a 1.1-point increase compared to same month of 2004.

LAN Airlines (“LAN”) is one of the leading airlines groups in Latin America. The LAN Alliance includes LAN Airlines, LAN Express, LAN Peru, LAN Ecuador, and LAN Argentina. Through its own operations and code-share arrangements, the LAN Alliance serves 15 destinations in Chile, eleven destinations in Peru, nine destinations in Argentina, two in Ecuador, 20 destinations in other Latin American countries, 25 in North America, ten destinations in Europe and four in the South Pacific. Currently, the LAN Alliance operates 57 passenger aircraft and eight dedicated freighters.
